- A. Approve compensation for elected town officials for next term as follows:
 - a. Chairperson - \$3200 Annually (paid March)
 - b. Supervisors - \$2100 Annually (paid March)
 - c. Clerk - \$6200 (paid over course of 12 months)
 - d. Treasurer - \$3800 (paid over course of 12 months)
- B. Motion to approve compensation for elected town official for next term
- C. Discuss/Approve compensation for Election (poll) Workers at \$12 an hour
- D. Authorize the Town Board to hire Town Officers as employees of the town and set their wages at:
 - a. Non-skilled labor \$12/hr
 - b. Skilled labor (grading roads/snow plowing) at \$22/hr
- E. Exceed Levy Limit for the town of Milladore
 - a. Motion of "resolution by town electors to **endorse** the town board's resolution to exceed the levy limit by \$10,000 a 9.23% increase"
 - b. Motion of "resolution of town electors to **adopt** the total town tax levy of \$118,289 at special town meeting of town electors"
