

Town of Milladore March 6, 2022 Meeting MINUTES

The March 6 Town of Milladore Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by Connie Milz with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Additions to the agenda included mail received by the Clerk.

The February 6 secretary report was read, Leon moved to approve, Hank seconded, motion carried.

Treasurer's report was read Hank moved to approve, Leon seconded, motion carried.

Old Business

Reviewed updates to five-year plan. Moved hiring a surveyor up to year 2022.

Emergency Management Plan is complete needs to be signed by Clerk and Chair and then posted to Website with a copy posted in the shop.

Request Hank to bring to the next Recycling Center meeting options of other Solid Waste Handler's in the area that could be more cost effective than what the Recycling center is currently using.

New Business

Annual Meeting is set for Tuesday, April 19 at 6:30pm.

The Spring Primary will be April 5, 2022.

Town Assessor (Kurt Moeller) set the Open Book for Friday, April 22 from 4 to 6pm with the Board of Review set for Friday, April 29 from 6:30pm to 8:30pm.

Received a BNI listing from Emergency Management of Wood County, reviewing names on list and identifying individuals who have passed on and/or moved and will relay that information back to Emergency Management to update. Received documentation that Jay Trowbridge and Jeff Bredl are getting BNI tiles.

Standing Agenda Items

Bids were posted in Marshfield New Herald for 5000 yards of gravel + or – to be delivered anywhere in the Town of Milladore; for 3000 yards + or – of Road base to be delivered anywhere in the Town of Milladore; for Calcium Chloride with Beet Juice for Dust control along with Bids for Brush cutting with one pass in June with three or more passes where needed in the fall. No bids were received at March meeting.

George Nigh from the Waushara County Highway department spoke about spraying a weed/brush inhibitor mid-April to end of May. Cost **rough estimate** \$250 a mile and will spray out to 40 feet, would need water truck.

Waiting for SMA from State before bids are placed for road work on Blueberry Road, which received LRIP funding.

Connie & Ron discussed Bi-Partisan Infrastructure Law bill which is Federal Money that can be used to repair bridges and new black top projects. Need to have an engineer hired to have noted within grant proposal. Missed first round of funding

because project requires coordination with DNR, however, planning to apply for second round of funding that could cover up to 80% of the cost of bridge repair project, if selected.

Additions to agenda, Clerk shared the following mail received:

- ArborVantage has a new mailing address
- Wood County Unit Meeting proposing to meet in March, June, September and December will be voted on at March 18 meeting
- Received notification from Republican Party if poll worker list given to Town must use names on list, all Town of Milladore poll workers are unaffiliated and no list of poll workers was received by Clerk from any political party
- Received information about CAP (Community Assets for People) Services
