

## Town of Milladore August 7, 2022 Meeting MINUTES

The August 7 Town of Milladore Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by Leon Kundinger with the Pledge of Allegiance.

No additions to the agenda.

The July 10 secretary report was read, Hank moved to approve, Leon seconded, motion carried.

Treasurer's report was read Leon moved to approve Hank seconded, motion carried.

### Old Business

Five year plan adjustment to add Cherney Road to 2024 with possible chip seal treatment.

### New Business

Clerk questioned the 1997 "Class B" Liquor License Quota information regarding the number of Liquor Licenses the Town of Milladore holds, which is one liquor license.

Clerk shared Alliant Energy Electric Overhead life extension project to replace like for like in updating powerlines.

Clerk Shared Department of Revenue Disbursements: School Tax Levy Payment \$64,919.06; Exempt Computer Aid \$38.45; First Dollar credit \$18,628.55; Shared Revenue July \$6,848.01

Shared Certified Map for Richard Bolder for new shop/winery building to be put up on property. Carmen and Rocky Bolder shared retirement plan of opening a Winery (called the Empty Next Winery) on the corner of Smoky Hill and Yellowstone Roads. Supervisors found no concerns.

Sanitary Permit for Mitch Miller 10565 Mayflower Road was shared.

### Standing Agenda Items

LAKES Asphalt is on the schedule for crack sealing repairs of Trestik Drive, Blenker Road, and Brookside Road.

Ron worked with DNR to cover \$4000 cost of granite on Blueberry Road north of County H. Discussed putting more granite down on roads, but too late in the season, will resume in spring.

Discussed bridge report inspections conducted by County in 2022 for smaller bridges in the town of Milladore, had never been done before.

Hank shared recycling center upcoming meeting on White Goods Day planned for September 10.

Nick & Hank Nigh shared Mutual Aid Box Alarm System Agreement Resolution with the Sherry Volunteer Fire Department to provide mutual aid to area towns when an emergency arises. Leon moved to approve, Hank seconded, motion carried. Clerk signed resolution.

No Additions to the agenda.

Public Comment: Bob shared a tree is leaning on Tower Road that would need to be removed before winter. Clerk shared WTA cards available for Board if wanted. Ron asked about land acquisition for possible future well, Clerk noted in WTA magazine this purchase needs to be voted on at an annual or budget meeting, clerk will gather more information to ascertain proper protocol for land acquisition for a town.
