

Town of Milladore January 8, 2023 Meeting MINUTES

The Milladore Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by Chris Hollar with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Additions to the agenda included clerk mail.

The December 4 secretary report was read, Hank moved to approve with corrections, Leon seconded, motion carried.

Treasurer's report was read Leon moved to approve Hank seconded, motion carried.

Old Business

Copies of the five-year plan for roads/buildings/equipment available for people to review.

Land acquisition, Ron was able to connect with Vic regarding a septic line coming out to the town hall (options Septic line or holding tank) in relation to where a well would be placed west of the Town Hall Building because of wetlands behind the Town Hall.

New Business

Clerk Shared updates from Rural Mutual Insurance of insurance coverage for 2021 Case 721G Wheel Endloader, Update to Payable loss provisions, and insurance document to be placed inside the dump truck, along with a Christmas Card and calendar.

The Town of Eau Pleine sent a check for \$400 for road maintenance of Deer Run Road for 2022.

Clerk shared the 2023 Final Calculation of General Transportation Aid of \$122,865.96 for 2023.

Clerk shared document of increase in Legal Posting fees for newspapers in 2023.

Certified Map SECTION 33 T25N R5E for Sheldon & Jeanne LaFlash was shared Leon moved to approved, Hank seconded, motion carried.

A Sanitary Permit for Ray and Connie Milz mound system was shared.

Standing Agenda Items

No complaints from School bus Company on keeping up with snow plowing.

Concern expressed over pile of snow off Maple Road, who put there and who will move it and discussed plowing of White Pine road to log off some of the wood back in that section.

Snow plowing has been going well. A concern was raised over Recycling Center salt, sand, and plowing of yard. Clerk will follow up with Town of Sherry to identify plan to either bill Town of Sherry for winter maintenance of Recycling Center yard or toggle back and forth plow, salt, and sanding the yard.

Pat Altmann shared that Jeff Grassl is interested in plowing out the Recycling Center yard as needed but he would need a key to get into the recycling center.

Hank shared Annual report of the Sherry Volunteer Fire Department. In 2022 The Sherry Volunteer Fire Department responded to 15 EMS calls and 4 fires which were down from 2021. In addition, there was an officer list, Board of Directors, Physician, Emergency Medical Responders and member listing.

Additions to the agenda

Clerk shared WTA Unit Meeting coming up on January 20 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church basement hosted by the Town of Port Edwards, along with listing of 2023 dates.

On call list provided by Wood County Highway Department along with upcoming Road Forum Meeting about funding opportunities with the County.

Clerk completed 2% dues for Fire Emergency System and shared that the State Mileage reimbursement per mile went up to .655 from .625 on January 1, 2023.

Confirmed that the Town of Milladore is not interested in sharing future responsibility for the Village of Milladore Park.
